What We're Doing in School



This half term, we are empowering children to trust their instincts, report worries, and use their voices to protect themselves and others.

- **Speak Up:** Learning to instantly tell a trusted adult if something online makes them feel scared, worried, or uncomfortable.
- **Never Your Fault:** Reassuring children that if they see something upsetting online, it is never their fault.
- **Reporting is Brave:** Understanding that reporting unkindness, inappropriate content, or strange behaviour is the responsible, brave thing to do.

How you can help at home

- ✓ **The Open Door Policy:** Remind your child: "In our house, we always talk about what happens online." Let them know they can never get in trouble for coming to you with an online worry.
- ✓ **Identify Trusted Adults:** Help your child name 3 trusted adults (at home and school) they could talk to if they ever felt worried online.
- ✓ **Explore CEOP Together:** Introduce older children to ceop.police.uk. Show them the 'CEOP button' found on popular sites and explain how it helps keep children safe.
